India inspires

The Foreign Minister of the Maldives Moosa Zameer on Friday said India has emerged as the world's largest and most diverse democracy that leads by example inspiring many countries, including his country.

Enthralling symphony

Earlier, the Indian mission said in a post on X: "The iconic Olympus Hall witnessed an enthralling symphony of Indian and Maldivian vocal and dance performances at 'Connecting Cultures'."

Zameer was speaking as a chief guest at a function on the 78th Independence Day of India here. The bilateral relations had recently seen a reset after the three-day visit of External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar, months of acrimony since pro-China Muizzu took oath last November.

Jaishankar visited the archipelagic nations earlier this month and met the country's top leadership, including President Muizzu. Before that, Muizzu visited New Delhi for the swearing-in ceremony of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's new government in June.

Earlier, within hours of his oath-taking, Muizzu had demanded India repatriate its military personnel from his country. After mutual negotiations, India withdrew its personnel by the agreed deadline of May 10 and replaced them with civilians.

On Friday, terming it as an 'honour' to be the chief guest at the event, Zameer extended on behalf of President Muizzu, the Government and the People of Maldives, warm greetings and best wishes to President Droupadi Murmu, Prime Minister Modi and to the friendly people of India.

"(I) Congratulated India for their remarkable journey, one of profound significance and inspiration. India has emerged as the world's largest and most diverse democracy that leads by example inspiring many countries, including the Maldives," Zameer posted on X after the event.

"I reflected on the long-standing partnership between Maldives and India - a partnership rooted in its people and strengthened through our active bilateral cooperation," he said.

He reiterated the firm commitment of President Muizzu's Government to strengthen and deepen the robust relationship between our two countries for the mutual benefit of our people. Zameer, in his longish post, said he also thanked External Affairs Minister Jaishankar for his unwavering support "to enhancing our bilateral ties."

He thanked India's Ambassador to the Maldives Munu Mahawar for hosting the event.

Mahawar, replying to his post, thanked Zameer for gracing "this celebration of our lasting friendship" and said: "We are confident that under the leadership of PM @narendramodi and President @Muizzu, our relationship will scale new heights and the bonds of friendship will become even stronger."

Gates hails India for breakthrough innovations

Washington D.C., Aug 17: India is a global leader with breakthrough innovations, American businessman and Microsoft founder Bill Gates has said as he joined Indian Americans to celebrate the first ever India Independence Day celebrations of the newly-

opened Indian Consulate in Seattle. Bill Gates, chairman of the India Foundation, flagged off the first India Day celebrations in the Greater Seattle area of the Consulate General of India's guest of honour on India's 78th Independence Day, a media release said.

Addressing the nearly 2,000 plus members of the Indian American community, he referred to India "as a global leader with breakthrough innovations in areas like technology, agriculture and healthcare". Gates further said, "From manufacturing safe low-cost vaccines to the remarkable leadership shown by the Indian diaspora in India's Digital Public Infrastructure - India's ingenuity is helping not just Indians, but the whole world. Countries across the Global South are leveraging India's experience to build their DPI systems."

Other participants at the India Day celebrations included Congressman Susan DelBene, Congresswoman Kim Schrier, Congressman Adam Smith, Lt. General Xavier Brunson, Commander of the America's First Corps in Pacific Northwest, Rear Admiral Mark Suenato, Commander of the Navy Region of North West, Washington Lieutenant Governor Denny Heck and Washington Secretary of State Steve Hobbs and Chief Justice from Washington Supreme Court Steve Gonzalez.

3-phase J&K Assembly elections from Sept 18

Haryana polls on Oct 1; all results on Oct 4

Decision welcomed

Political parties on Friday welcomed the announcement of much awaited Assembly polls in Jammu and Kashmir by the Election Commission of India. Jammu and Kashmir will go to the assembly polls in three phases, beginning from September 18, after a decade and first since the abrogation of Article 370.

Chief Election Commissioner Rajiv Kumar, announcing the schedule here on Friday said the next two phases of voting will take place on September 25 and October 1. The Counting of votes will take place on October 4 along with votes polled in Haryana Assembly elections which will be held on October 1.

No Assembly elections have been held in Jammu and Kashmir in the last 10 years and the union territory has been without an elected government for the past six years, following the PDP-BJP coalition Government fell in June 2018, when the BJP withdrew support.

The election schedule for J&K and Haryana was announced by Rajiv Kumar along with the two Election Commissioners Gyanesh Kumar and Sukhbir Singh Sandhu, after the Supreme Court directed that Assembly election in Jammu and Kashmir should be held by September 30.

The CEC said that the polling will be held for 90 assembly seats in Jammu and Kashmir, out of which 74 are general, and 16 reserved for ST, SC & 7. Talking about the voters data, he said a total 87.09 lakh voters are there in Jammu and Kashmir, including 44.46 lakh male voters and 42.62 lakh female voters.

Rajiv Kumar also made a stark observation over holding the election in J&K, saying that the people in Jammu and Kashmir "chose ballots over bullets". "In the Lok Sabha election held in April and May this year, J&K achieved its highest voter turnout in 35 years, recording 58.46 percent" he added.

"We recently visited Jammu & Kashmir and Haryana to take stock of the election preparation. A great enthusiasm was seen among the people. They wanted to participate in the election process, he said, adding that this glimpse of hope and democracy shows that the people want to change the picture. They want to write their own destiny" the CEC said.

As per the ECI, the dates for issuing the gazette notification for the three phases election in J&K will be on August 20, August 29, and September 5 respectively. In 2014, BJP won 25 seats, PDP 28, Congress 27, September 05 and September 12 respectively. There about 2.01 crore voters in Haryana, said the CEC.

Rajiv Kumar said there are about 90 Assembly constituencies in Haryana. In 2019, BJP had won 40 seats while Congress 31. Welcoming the announcement of the election in J&K, BJP incharge of Jammu and Kashmir Tarun Chugh said, "The BJP is a responsible political party and will positively participate in the polls. We will surely receive the public's blessings."

"Under the leadership of PM Modi and Union Home Minister Amit Shah, Jammu and Kashmir has become free of Article 370. People have faith in Modi and J&K is moving forward," he said.

US, Egypt, Qatar to resume Gaza peace talks

Cairo, Aug 17: Egyptian President Abdel-Fattah al-Sisi and his US counterpart Joe Biden reviewed on Friday the outcomes of ceasefire negotiations held in Qatar's capital Doha over the past two days.

During a phone conversation, the two presidents discussed the situation in the Middle East and efforts to restore regional stability, the Egyptian presidency said in a statement.

The two leaders agreed to continue and intensify joint efforts in the coming days to reach an agreement in this regard, the statement said.

Sisi stressed the continuation of Egyptian contacts with various parties in the region to urge non-escalation and self-restraint, in light of the gravity of the situation in the Middle East, it said.

The Egyptian President also affirmed the need to respect the sovereignty of states and prevent the region from sliding into a vicious cycle of confrontations and violence, it added.

The United States, Egypt and Qatar, mediators of the Gaza ceasefire talks, announced on Friday that the two-day discussions in Doha have concluded, with plans to reconvene in Cairo next week to finalise a deal aimed at ending the conflict.

In a joint statement, they described the talks as constructive and conducted in a positive environment.

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's office expressed gratitude for the mediators' efforts and hoped they would lead Hamas to accept the terms of a proposal made in late May.

Meanwhile, Hamas, which did not participate directly, accused Israel of adding new conditions to a previously supported proposal, and accused the Biden administration of trying to create a "false positive atmosphere", expressing skepticism about the negotiations' outcome.
