This Report is required by the Company for the purpose of submission with Catalyst Trusteeship Limited (hereinafter the "Debenture Trustee") of the Company to ensure compliance with the SEBI Circular in respect of its senior, secured, redeemable, rated, listed, non-convertible debentures (hereinafter referred to as "Debentures"). The Company has entered into agreements with the Debenture Trustee (collectively referred to as "Debenture Trust Deed") in respect of such Debentures as indicated in the Statement.

Management's Responsibility:

4. The preparation of the Statement is the responsibility of the Management of the Company including the preparation and maintenance of all accounting and other relevant supporting records and documents. This responsibility includes the design, implementation, and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and presentation of the Statement and applying an appropriate basis of preparation; and making estimates that are reasonable in the circumstances.

- 5. The management of the Company is responsible for ensuring that the Company complies with all the relevant requirements of the SEBI circular and SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, Companies Act, 2013 and other applicable laws and regulations, as applicable including providing all relevant information to the Debenture Trustee.
- 6. The Management is also responsible to ensure that Assets Cover Ratio as on June 30, 2025 is in compliance with SEBI circular no. SEBI/HO/MIRSD/MIRSD_CRADT/CIR/P/2022/67 dated May 19, 2022 with the minimum asset cover requirement of hundred percent as per the SEBI Regulations as given in Annexure I attached to this certificate.

Auditor's Responsibility

- 7. It is our responsibility to provide a limited assurance and conclude as to whether the:
 - a. Book values of assets as included in the Statement are in agreement with the books of account underlying the unaudited financial results of the company as at June 30, 2025.
 - b. Company is in compliance with financial covenants as mentioned in the Debenture Trust Deed as on June 30, 2025.
 - c. To certify asset cover ratio is minimum hundred percent as per the minimum requirement stated in SEBI Regulations.
- 8. We have performed a limited review of the unaudited financial results of the Company for the quarter ended June 30, 2025, prepared by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 52 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended, and issued an unmodified conclusion dated August 14, 2025. Our review of those financial results was conducted in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410, "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity", issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India ("ICAI").
- 9. We conducted our examination of the Statement in accordance with the Guidance Note on Reports or Certificates for Special Purposes issued by the ICAI (the "Guidance Note"). The Guidance Note requires that we comply with the ethical requirements of the Code of Ethics issued by the ICAI.
- 10. We have complied with the relevant applicable requirements of the Standard on Quality Control (SQC) 1, Quality Control for Firms that Perform Audits and Review of Historical Financial Information, and Other Assurance and Related Services Engagements.
- 11. Our scope of work did not involve us performing audit tests for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the fairness or accuracy of any of the financial information or the financial results of the company taken as a whole. We have not performed an audit, the objective of which would be expressing an opinion on the financial results, specified elements, accounts or items thereof, for the purpose of this report. Accordingly, we do not express an opinion.
- 12. A limited assurance engagement includes performing procedures to obtain sufficient appropriate evidence on the applicable criteria, mentioned in paragraph 6 above. The procedures performed vary in nature and timing from, and are less extent than for, a reasonable assurance. Consequently, the level of assurance obtained is substantially lower than the assurance that would have been obtained had a reasonable assurance engagement been performed. Accordingly, our procedures included the following in relation to the Statement on the sample basis:
 - a. Obtained and read the Information Memorandum and DTD issued by the Company and noted that the Company is required to maintain security cover.
 - b. Obtained the Board approved unaudited financial results of the Company for the quarter ended June 30, 2025.
 - c. Obtained a list of financial covenants applicable to the listed debt securities.
 - d. Obtained and read the Debenture Trust Deed and the Information Memorandum in respect of the secured Debentures and noted the asset cover percentage required to be maintained by the Company in respect of such Debentures, as Indicated in Annexure I of the Statement.

- e. With respect to compliance with financial covenants included in the Statement, we have performed the following procedures. Obtained the various financial metrics forming part of the financial covenants mentioned in the Debenture trust Deed as calculated by the management as at June 30, 2025 and compared the financial metrics with the unaudited financial results to the extent directly traceable and to the financial information from the books of account underlying the unaudited financial results.
- f. Performed necessary inquiries with the management regarding any instances of noncompliance with financial covenants or communications received from the Trustee indicating any breach of covenants during the period ended June 30, 2025.
- g. Traced and agreed the carrying value of Debentures outstanding as on June 30, 2025 to the Board approved unaudited financial results of the Company and the underlying books of account maintained by the Company as on June 30, 2025.
- h. Obtained the list of security created in the register of charges maintained by the Company and 'Form No. CHG-9' filed with Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA'). Traced the value of charge created against Assets to the Security Cover in the attached Statement.
- Obtained the list and value of assets placed under lien or encumbrance for the purpose of obtaining any other loan and determined that such assets are not included in the calculation of Security Cover in respect of Debentures.
- j. Examined and verified the arithmetical accuracy of the computation of Security Cover, disclosed in the accompanying Statement.
- k. Traced the book value of assets from the books of accounts of the company underlying the Board approved unaudited financial results as at June 30, 2025.
- I. Performed necessary inquiries with the Management and obtained necessary representations.

Conclusion

13. Based on the procedures performed by us, as referred to in paragraph 11 above and according to the information and explanations received and management representations obtained, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that: a) The Book values of assets as included in the Statement are not in agreement with the books of account underlying the unaudited financial results of the company as at June 30, 2025. b) Company is not in compliance with financial covenants as mentioned in the Debenture Trust Deed as on June 30, 2025.

Restriction of Use

14. The Report has been issued at the request of the Company, solely in connection with the purpose mentioned in paragraph 2 above and to be submitted with the accompanying Statement to the Debenture Trustee and is not to be used or referred to for any other person. Accordingly, we do not accept or assume any liability or any duty of care for any other purpose or to any other person to whom this report is shown or into whose hands it may come. We have no responsibility to update this Report for events and circumstances occurring after the date of this report.
